

Treasurer's Report 2014-15

It has been another very successful year for Eaton Primary PTA, raising £8674.77 through various fundraising activities. Again the discos, Easter Fayre, Santa's Workshop and summer fete were large fundraisers together with the bake sales, WWYW and Spree. The ice-cream sales were such a huge success that we needed to purchase an extra freezer to store stock! The ice-cream sales raised £655.21 in just one term.

The Christmas projects which included the school play DVD, calendars and Christmas cards raised an impressive £1063.75. The inaugural Quiz and Chips night was a runaway success and raised £371.

Activities which have required little PTA participation – Bags2school, Easyfundraising and Label Planet have raised £633.71.

The PTA has also had a successful year funding various projects within the school. The PTA bought 2 table tennis tables which have been installed in the junior playground. All school years were given money towards a school trip in the summer term. The PTA has also provided new netball bibs and PE t-shirts to be worn at external PE fixtures when representing the school. The PTA organised and funded the Year 6 leaver's party as in previous years.

At the end of the school year, we have a closing balance of £9519.26. This is higher than previous years as we have raised more money this year but we have not had a large fundraising project to concentrate on which will hopefully happen this year.

All fundraising activities have been well supported and well organised – a massive thanks to all PTA members for all their hard work and dedication.
