This first half of term we have been spending as much time outside as possible during After School Club. We have been doing craft activities such as apple printing, clay models, playdough, junk modelling, drawing and cutting and sticking. As well as a range of sport activities we have also taken construction toys, board games, card games and puzzles outside. Our theme this half of term is Animals and Harvest and our craft activities are based **loosely** around these topics. We do plan to continue to spend as much time outside as possible in the coming months. Please can I remind parents to send their children in with coats etc as the weather becomes cooler. After half term our topics will include Halloween, Winter and Christmas. We also hope to do some cooking activities again. If anyone has any simple and quick ideas/recipes I would be very grateful.

Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am until 8.50am. Due to the increase in numbers we would appreciate it if children eating breakfast arrive no later than **8.15am**. This allows your child to have a relaxed breakfast and enough time for us to clear away before the start of school. We serve a selection of cereals, toast, crumpets and a variety of spreads, along with yogurts, fruit and fruit juices.

After School Club runs from 3.15pm until 6pm and ask that children are collected by 6pm. In keeping with our terms and conditions we can charge parents an extra fee if their child is collected later than 6pm. At After School Club snack we serve a variety of sandwiches, bread and butter, crackers, cheese, spreads, tomatoes, cucumber, peppers, fruit and squash.

Both Breakfast and After School Clubs have become much busier and there are sessions that are fully booked and we are unable to accept any more children at these sessions. We want to continue to give a good service and not become too big so the clubs become impersonal. We ask that if you wish to book any extra sessions for your child/children that you give as much notice as possible and we will try to accommodate you. At the moment Tuesdays for both clubs are full until the end of term.

We are always pleased to accept any unwanted toys in good condition and also items for junk modelling.
