<p>With a grown up, have a look at the houses on your street.</p> <p>Record the different numbers that you see. Do you notice a pattern? <p>Ask your grown-up if you can look at the change that they have in their purse or pocket.</p> <p>What coins do they have? How many different coins can you see? What coin has the biggest/smallest value?</p>	<p>Design your own traditional tale character.</p> <p>Are they good or bad? Where do they live? What do they look like?</p>
<p>Practise some number facts to 10.</p> <p>Can you recall all of your number bonds to 10 with an adult?</p>	<p>Describe your family</p> <p>Draw a picture of your family and write down what is special about your family.</p>
<p>Bake some Gingerbread men.</p> <p>Weigh the ingredients carefully. What numbers can you find in the recipe?</p>	<p>Create an electronic picture.</p> <p>Draw a picture from a traditional tale using an electronic device and save it.</p>
<p>Make a “Teens Shop” where everything costs a teen number.</p> <p>Show how much money you could use to pay for each item, using 10ps and 1ps only.</p>	<p>Make a fairytale character.</p> <p>Make a sculpture, puppet or portrait of your favourite traditional tale character.</p>
<p>One more or one less.</p> <p>Choose 5 numbers and tell an adult one more and one less than that number.</p>	<p>Den building</p> <p>Using materials in your local environment (e.g. sticks, straw, leaves,etc), to make a shelter.</p>
<p>Forwards and backwards.</p> <p>Choose 5 numbers and practise counting forwards and backwards from it.</p>	<p>Find your 5 favourite stories.</p> <p>What are they called? Who wrote them? Why are they your favourite?</p>
