<p>Write subtraction number sentences for numbers up to 10. (e.g. $9-3=6$)</p> <p>How many can you come up with without using numbers over 10?</p>	<p>Imagine that you are going to visit London.</p> <p>Using books, the internet or talking to people in your family, plan a trip around London.</p>
<p>How old are you?</p> <p>What happens if you add your age with your brother or sister? If you don't have a sibling, you can double your age.</p> <p>Ask your grown-up how old they are. How many tens and units are in their age? Ask another grown-up how old they are. Who has more tens in their age?</p>	<p>Using fire as your inspiration, create a piece of art.</p> <p>It can be anything that you imagine, using any medium you would like or a combination of mediums.</p>
<p>Picking up toys around your room.</p> <p>Which toy do you think is the heaviest? Lightest? Can you find any two toys that feel like they weigh the same?</p>	<p>Have a go at making bread!</p> <p>Follow the recipes instructions and enjoy with your family.</p>
<p>Create a 2D shape picture.</p> <p>Only using 2D shapes can you recreate a picture of the fire of London.</p>	<p>Create a poster to sell your home-made bread.</p> <p>What power words will you need? How much will you sell a slice for?</p>
<p>Make a hopscotch board.</p> <p>Only instead of filling it in ones, count on in 2s, 5s or 10s.</p>	<p>Keep a diary for a day.</p> <p>Can you use time words to sequence your events and/or draw them in the order you do them.</p>
<p>Estimate how many snacks there are.</p> <p>Buy your favourite snack and estimate how many pieces are inside the packet.</p>	<p>Visit a bakery.</p> <p>What power words can you think of to describe what you can see/smell/hear?</p>
