

Year 4 Curriculum Map for Autumn Term 2

Topic

Our topic for this half-term will be Norfolk. We will be looking at maps of the UK to identify countries and major cities. We will be identifying human and physical features in photos and on maps. We shall study the development of a river and its impact on the surrounding areas and trade links. We shall also look at the characteristics of living things, habitats and food chains. We will be comparing the geographical similarities and differences between different areas of Norfolk.

Art

We will be studying the work of the illustrator and printmaker Mark Hearld. We will be building up collages through developing techniques in leaf rubbing and print making.
