<p>Draw a poster that shows the links between fractions, decimals and percentages.</p>	<p>Write a film review for your favourite film. Include sentences using semi colons.</p>
<p>Find ten interesting numbers that are related to films. For example, how much people earn, how many people were involved in production, how much films cost, etc.</p>	<p>Write a letter of application for a part in your favourite film that you would like to star in. Think about how to persuade the director to hire you! You <u>could</u> use modal verbs in this.</p>
<p>Draw a poster for a film that is contained within a rectangle. Find out the area of that rectangle! Remember to multiply the width by the length!</p>	<p>Create your own comic book superhero character that could be in a film that already exists or a new film.</p>
<p>How long could you survive on a desert island like Michael in Kensuke's Kingdom? Explain your answer using numbers and calculations.</p>	<p>Watch a music video that you like. Storyboard what happens in this.</p>
<p>Look up to see which films are on at a local cinema. Find ten films and find out how long they are. Order them from shortest to longest.</p>	<p>Look at the universal studios website. Design your own new ride for a film of your choice.</p>
<p>Find out how maths is linked to light (our Science topic). Present your findings in an interesting way (as a follow up to our previous science topic).</p>	<p>Change the song lyrics to a song that you really like. You could make it funny. Try to use some subordinating conjunctions.</p>
<p>Google 'Pixar in a Box'. Watch the video and find out how maths is used to create Pixar films.</p>	<p>Choose a photograph that you have taken and turn it into a piece of Art.</p>
