Science – What are important skills for a scientist?

In this unit the children will be working scientifically, focusing on different parts of the practical experimental process. For example, we will be looking at observing, testing, gathering and recording data. The children will also be making choices regarding the experiment and asking questions themselves.

Maths

This half term we will be applying the learning we have completed so far this year to tackle more complex maths problems. We will be returning to place value and practicing our counting knowledge of 2, 3, 5 and 10. We will also use our understanding of place value to solve addition and subtraction number problems. We will be collecting data and presenting it using block graphs, tally charts and Venn diagrams. We will also be looking at the position and direction of shapes through rotation.
