




Spring Term 2 Year 1 Homework Assignments

You must choose 4 maths and 4 topic homework assignments to complete in your homework log book every half term. If you want to do extra – that’s great! You will receive house points for every completed assignment. Homework logs can be handed in during the week and will be marked and returned by Friday. Please encourage children to complete the tasks at their own pace within the half term. Please feel free to comment on how your child has found each task. We encourage children to record their work in whatever form suits their learning style and the task at hand.

Maths Choose 4 to complete	Topic Choose 4 to complete
Look at a calendar. How many Mondays are there in February this year? Can you do the same for all of the other days of the week?	Set up your own teddy bear hospital.
Go on a shape hunt. How many different shapes can you see? Is there a shape you see the most, if so, why?	Make a poster explaining to others about how to live a healthy lifestyle.
Have a go at a tessellating picture using shapes. 	With help from an adult research Florence Nightingale. Can you come up with some questions to try and answer?
Count in 2s, 5s and 10s. What patterns can you see?	Create a piece of artwork inspired by what you already know about germs.
Practice place value with an adult, using Shark numbers. http://www.ictgames.com/sharkNumbers/sharkNumbers_v5.html Download the Shark Numbers app to play on an iPad.	Design a nurse’s toolkit. What are the most important items?
Investigate: Can all numbers be halved and doubled? Note: we do not teach decimals in Year 1.	Run a class where you teach your parents/family/teddies how to wash their hands properly.
Practice telling the time to an adult. Write down what time you go to bed and wake up.	Draw a picture of your favourite animal and label the parts of the body.
