



South America



This curriculum newsletter provides an overview of your child's learning this half term in year six. Where it is possible, we will make learning links with our topic, 'South America', to help the children place their learning in context.

ENGLISH

The children will experience a range of writing genres linked to our topic. This will include writing based on our key text, "Trash".

Children will read a range of texts in guided reading groups and carry out analysis activities to develop their range of reading skills.

In **Science** the children will be learning about the classification of living things (animals and humans).

In **Geography** the children will be learning about key aspects of human and physical geography and how nature has helped to shape this.

MATHEMATICS

The children will be developing their understanding of proportionality, specific aspects of calculation, and revising topics covered so far.

We will make links between our topic and mathematics where they arise.

In **Music** the children will be learning about South American carnival music.

In **Art** the children will be studying a famous South American artist.

In **COMPUTING** the children will use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly, recognise acceptable and unacceptable behaviour, and identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and contact.

In **PE** the children will be practising and developing skills related to hockey.

In **RE** the children will be learning about Christianity.

In **PSHE** the children will be developing skills for healthy relationships and recognise different types of relationships.

In **Spanish** the children will be learning basic conversation through song and activities.
