<p>Draw your own line graph using data that you have found about South America. Create five questions that could be asked about this graph.</p>	<p>Research an artist from South America; tell us all about them and create your own piece of art using their style e.g. Omar Rayo.</p>
<p>Make a model of a house in a favela. Carry out some internet research beforehand to find pictures and inspiration. Think about which mathematical shapes would work the best.</p>	<p>Write a biography about a famous South American.</p>
