<p>Time Can you write the days of the week and the months of the year in order?</p> <p>Can you answer these questions? How many days are in a week? How many months are in a year? Which month comes after March? Which month is your birthday in? Which month is Christmas in?</p> <p>Investigate Investigate how many days are in a year? What is a leap year?</p>	<p>Reading Design a front cover for your favourite book. Remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It should look attractive. • It should have title. • It should have characters from the story. <p>Practise your Read Write Inc sounds at home. If you have sound cards in your book bag please use them. Teach your family too. Use the link to Twinkl practise reading real and alien words. <p>Shape What shapes can you find around your home? You could look for flat 2D shapes such as a square or fat 3D shapes such as a cylinder (tin of beans).</p> <p>Keep a tally chart to record how many of each shape you find. Which shape did you find the most of? Which shape did you find the least of?</p>	<p>Spelling and handwriting Follow the link to practise your spellings, you can play some fun games on here as well as learning important spelling rules. Try a new rule every day. https://www.spellzone.com/curriculum/national-curriculum/year-1.cfm</p> <p>Practise forming your letters correctly when writing. Remember the phrases that we use in our phonics lessons. These can be found on Google.</p>
<p>Place Value How many ways can you show the number 32?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Remember you could use toys, counters, cubes. - Draw 32 in tens and ones. - Make 32 using addition and subtraction sentences. - Be creative: draw flowers – how many petals will you need on each? etc. 	<p>Grammar Recognise what a noun is (it is the name of an object, place or person)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Playing I spy game. All the objects we see are nouns – names of things and people. Imagine we are at the sea side/in space/in a forest – play imaginary I spy. • Playing 'Mime It' game. A person has to mime a noun and everyone else has to ask. You can help by giving the children categories e.g. something you can find in the kitchen, an animal etc. • Alphabet races: challenge yourself to find animals/names/names of places that start with consecutive letters of the alphabet. Example: antelope, bear, cat, dog.
<p>Problem Solving Noah saw 12 legs walk by into the Ark. How many creatures could he have seen? How many different answers can you find?</p> 	<p>Sentence structure – can you put the words in the right order to make a sentence? (visit the website to play the game) https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/24635.htm !</p>
<p>Place Value How many tens and ones are in these numbers: 9, 16, 21, 34, 46, 50.</p>	<p>Writing composition</p> <p>Describe how the trees and flowers change throughout the different seasons. This could be a descriptive piece of writing using adjectives or you could write facts about what happens when the seasons change. It would be lovely if you could also draw a picture to go with your writing.</p>
<p>Times tables Use the website times tables rock stars to practise your two, five and ten times tables. https://trockstars.com/ Practise your times tables for 30 minutes a day.</p>	
<p>Addition up to 20 Continue working on addition calculations. https://www.coloringsquared.com/wp-content/uploads/2013/10/Free-Addition-Worksheet-Activities-AAHC4-Rose-Math-For-Kids.pdf</p>
