Dear Parent/Carer.

We are pleased to offer your child the opportunity to take part in a Bikeability, Learn to Ride lesson.

Bikeability Learn to Ride is an initiative to help children learn how to ride a bike. It is designed for those children who are unable to cycle – in particular children who, for whatever reason, are struggling to master the skill.

Bikeability Learn to Ride is delivered by qualified cycling instructors in a constructive, low pressure environment ideal for beginners. It is a learner-focused training session with an emphasis on working with trainees at their own pace to learn how to ride.

Learn to Ride is run in groups of 6 children with two Instructors. The lessons will be delivered as two, 45 minute sessions. Children will need to bring their own bike and helmet to the session. Please could we ask you to remove the stabilisers and pedals before the first session so they can learn to balance on their bike. They will then have a chance to practice at home before the next session, a week later. For the second session, please put the pedals back on. Hopefully after the second session they will be able to ride independently.

If you would like your child to take part, please return the below form to Mrs Barker by Friday 6 November 2020.

Sessions will begin on Monday 30 November. Once you have returned your form you will be notified of a date.
