Key Definitions

Chronological - following the order in which events occurred.

Repel – push away

Experiment – to test and find something out

Evaluate – to decide if you have done something in the best way or if you could improve it.

Florence Nightingale (1820 – 1910) – The founder of modern nursing. She cared for soldiers during the Crimean War and transformed hospitals into safe, hygienic places.

Queen Victoria (1819 – 1901) – The Queen of England for 63 years!

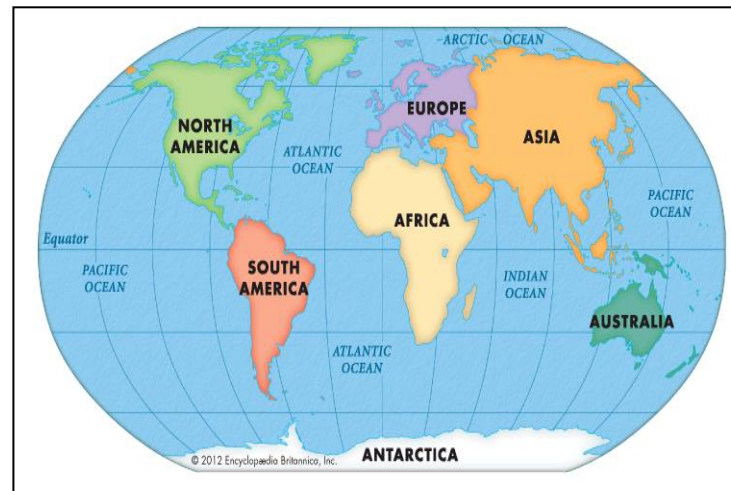
