





**Autumn Term 2- Reception

Maths Choose 4 to complete	Topic Choose 4 to complete
<p>Use objects from home, e.g. crayons, counters, toy cars. Starting with different numbers, practise adding one or two more. Can you find how many there are altogether?</p> 	<p>Understanding the World- History Find out about Bonfire Night and why it is celebrated. Write some facts about it.</p> 
<p>Practise counting actions as you do them, e.g. claps, star jumps, tapping your knee, banging a drum</p> 	<p>Understanding the World- The World and People and Communities</p>  <p>Find out about the Christmas story. What do you do to get ready for festivals in your house?</p> <p>Draw some pictures/ write to show this.</p>
<p>Place numbers cards in order from 1-10 or higher.</p> 	<p>Exploring Media and Materials- Music</p> <p>Can you create different firework sounds? You could use parts of your body or create instruments using junk modelling.</p>
<p>Use different foods of your choice, e.g. segments of orange, grapes, chocolate raisins. Starting with different numbers, talk about how many will be left if one or two is eaten.</p> 	<p>Communication and Language Find out about Diwali. Talk about how it is celebrated with your grown-up.</p>  <p>Can you draw pictures/ write some facts you find out?</p>


Create a picture using shapes e.g. a house, clown, train, rocket. Can you name and talk about the shapes you have used?
