





Summer 1- Year 1

<p>Find a packet of seeds – empty the seeds out onto some kitchen paper. How many seeds do you have? Count how many you have in the packet in groups of 2s, 5s or 10s.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Visit a garden centre.</p> <p>What WOW words can you think of to describe what you can hear/see/smell?</p>
