**Living thing:** 7 characteristics – Movement, Respiration, Sensitivity, Nutrition, Excretion, Reproduction and Growth.

**Classification:** To organise, group and order.

**Observation:** To closely notice and monitor.

**Adapted:** Changing to better suit a situation or the environment.

### Geography:

**Human features:** Made by humans and influenced and changed by humans

**Physical features:** the natural features of the earth.

### Computing

**Algorithm:** Step-by-step instructions for a computer to follow.

### Art

**Tone:** Lightness and darkness of colour

**Applique:** ornamental needlework where pieces or patches of patterned or shaped fabric are sewn or stuck into a larger piece.

### Music

**Timbre:** the sound or tone quality, of a note played on an instrument


**Texture:** The mix and layers of sounds.

Tiger in a Tropical Storm




The Equatorial Jungle
